

Wright City Church Repair

Workmen have repaired the steeple at the United Church of Christ in Wright City. The imitation brick siding and several areas of crumbling concrete have been replaced with aluminum.



New Steeple In Wright City

The top was finally set in place for the Immanuel United Church of Christ in Wright City. The new 40 foot Steeple was set on the church on Tuesday, November 25.

Leroy Collins, of the B&L Steel Erection Co. of Elsherry, brought his 85 foot long telescoping crane to hoist the 1,500 pound steeple unit into place atop the 45 foot belfry. Neal Ordelhelde called the signals from his perch atop the belfry as the steeple slowly ascended, as Dennis Brakensiek steadied it with the tether rope. Bill Flesch, Carl Meyer and Doc Barkey guided the steeple unit into place as it was lowered down over them.

Assisting from the ground was Frank Reich and Bill Groeper. The crew of volunteer spent the next few hours inside the bell tower anchoring the steeple firmly to the church.
