#### WHY HAVE A PASTORAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE?

There are three basic reasons for a congregation to have a PRC:

1. Building Up The Body of Christ

The first reason is to build up the life of the church and its ministry. The church is the body of Christ, knit together by God for the mutual up-building of life. Ephesians 4:15-16 says: Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by every joint with which it is supplied, when each part is working properly, makes bodily growth and up-builds itself in love. This responsibility calls for sensitive care and careful discernment regarding what is beneficial, and is to be exercised in a humble and loving way.

2. Support

The second reason to have a PRC is to provide

focused, consistent support for the pastor. Ministry is a high stress profession. The high levels of personal and congregational expectations contribute to the need for support. Being a primary care-giver, the pastor needs a supportive environment for renewal.

#### 3. Feedback And Communication

The third reason for a congregation to have a PRC is to provide a regular channel of communication for cultivating an open, affirmative and creative relationship between the pastor and congregation, and enabling the church to fulfill its mission effectively. Communication is a vital ingredient in the provision of support.

Please keep these thoughts in mind as we move through 2016 working to keep an open relationship with our minister and congregation. Contact committee chairperson, Bud Nissen or Pastor Tom with your thoughts about our ministry at Immanuel UCC.

#### FROM THE PASTOR:

Lent is one of the most important times in life of the church. It prepares us for the celebration of Easter and the resurrection of our Savior. Lent is 40 days before Easter (not counting Sundays as every Sunday is a celebration of the resurrection). The date of Easter varies from year to year. The date is determined in this way: the first Sunday after the first full moon of the spring equinox! Therefore; in 2016 Easter will be March 27.

Ash Wednesday will be February 10. We at Immanuel will be observing Lent by having worship services each Wednesday with a light meal in Fellowship Hall at 6:00 p.m. and the service will be at 7:00 p.m.

I plan on having services last no longer than 45 minutes since children will need to get to bed at a reasonable time and also for those who get up early

for work. The Evening Circle will get people to prepare soup and then there will be sandwiches and dessert.

This year I am planning of preaching each week on one of the Seven Last Words Jesus spoke from the cross. On Ash Wednesday, the title will be "Father, Forgive Them for They Know Not What They Do." We will also have Holy Communion and the Imposition of Ashes.

February 17 the Word from the cross will be "Today, Thou shalt be with me in Paradise." February 24 the Word from the Cross will be "Son, Behold Your Mother - Mother Behold Your Son."

In March we will continue with the remaining words.


