Secretary's Report: Lee made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, Terry seconded, motion carried.

Financial Secretary's Report: Lee made the motion to approve the report as presented, Beverley seconded, motion carried.

General Treasurer's Report: Beverley made the motion to approve the report as presented, Lee seconded, motion carried.

Pastor's Report: The Conference Minister is wearing Muslim clothes during Lent so she knows what It is like to be a Muslin. Rev. Higgins wishes to pay for the dinner after Church June 11, 2017 in his celebration of being ordained for 50 years. The meal will be catered by Wright City Meat Company.


