Agape vs. Wright City Food Pantry

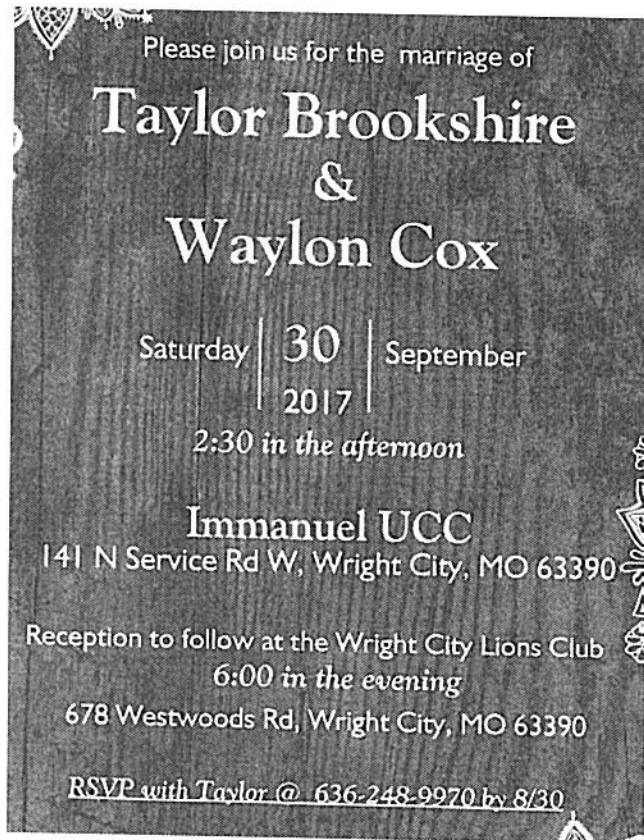

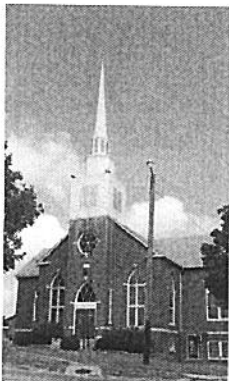
